Good Friends,

Over the last couple of months, I have been reminded that God does not protect us from challenging economic times or difficult decisions.

It was a difficult decision for the Session to recommend to the congregation at the annual meeting the financial necessity to close the Associate Pastor for Congregational Care position and say good-bye to Pastor Phyllis. Likewise, it was a difficult decision for the congregation to approve the recommendation, even with the encouragement by Pastor Phyllis in the statement she read to those attending the meeting.

Beginning October, 2005, Pastor Phyllis' ministry of congregational care has meant so much to so many within the family of Hope. Pastor Phyllis' last Sunday will be February 14. A reception is planned in the Fellowship Hall for the congregation to express their appreciation for her ministry. The congregation approved granting Pastor Phyllis 6-month severance of her salary and housing, and continuing her monthly dues to the Presbyterian Church's Board of Pension which includes her major medical insurance and minister's retirement.

The Personnel Committee of Session will be working with Pastor Holly and myself to determine the best ways to continue the congregational care ministry of Hope without benefit of a full-time associate pastor with those dedicated responsibilities. In the meantime, the Board of Deacons and Care Ministry Teams are still endeavoring to provide congregational care of members. It is important that you keep the church office informed when you or a family member is hospitalized. This will assure that the pastors of Hope and congregational care leaders can make appropriate responses.

Christian faith requires that we focus on the work God has placed before us. We are called to reach out inviting the unchurched to come and learn of Jesus Christ as we worship God, We are called to grow in our understanding of God's unconditional love for ourselves and our neighbors. We are called to be equipped and be open to mission work on behalf of Christ wherever we see the need.

Thank you for your prayers, your leadership, and your faithfulness as we reach and serve for Jesus Christ.

ASH WEDNESDAY – February 17 7:00 P.M. EVENING WORSHIP

Ash Wednesday is an ancient holy day in the Christian year marking the beginning of Lent – a time of prayerful reflection on personal discipleship. Ashes were adopted from a custom of ancient Israel that was a reminder of the pervasiveness of human sin and death. The imposition of ashes is a central part of the worship experience. The Ash Wednesday worship reminds us of our mortality as we confess our sins and experience God’s forgiveness through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ. This evening worship service begins our Lenten preparations and points ahead toward the fingerprint of God’s grace in the passion of Jesus Christ during Holy Week and Easter Resurrection. The evening worship service includes hymns, scripture lessons, message by Pastor Fred, and the imposition of ashes on foreheads of those who desire the experience.

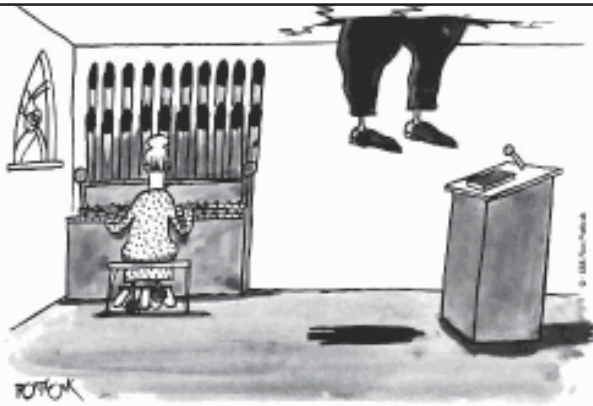

Generation to Generation

In 2009, the Generation to Generation Fund's principle and earnings grew from \$105,698 to \$233,305. This reflects the generous giving of members, the growth and recovery of the fund, and a significant gift from the Kerr Estate.

Over the past year, the Fund's earnings grew from a deficit of \$24,027 to a surplus or profit of \$2,590. This significant recovery and growth of \$26,617 is a reflection of staying invested and having exposure to international markets.

The earnings from this endowment will continue to help our church grow in the future. To date, grants of \$12,257 have helped a variety of endeavors. A few of these have been: electrical wiring for Restoration House in Brazil, a boy's shelter; a roof for House of Hope, Managua, Nicaragua which helps abused women and children; a new computer server for our church; and money to cover training expenses for our Care-Ministry and Discipleship.

We know these grants given in previous years have helped and will continue to help Hope Church and many local and international ministries. And, that we will be able to provide additional grants to help growth in the future.

Hope Presbyterian Church members may register their children (not currently enrolled) for the Hope Children's Center 2010-2011 school year on Friday, February 12. You may come to the HCC office from 9:30 – 1:30.

If an opening is available for your child, you will receive an enrollment packet to complete at that time. A registration/supply fee and May 2011 tuition payment, for each child, are required to be paid in full (cash or check payable to Hope Children's Center) when you enroll your child. Both fees are non-refundable.

You will be enrolling your child for an entire school year to begin in September 2010 through mid-May 2011. If classes are full you may place your child on a Waiting List for a \$15.00 fee.
